POLICY: STUDENT USE OF CARS/MOTORBIKES - UPDATED JUNE 2020

By signing this document we agree to co-operate and abide by the Student Use of Cars/ Motorbikes Policy of Salesian Secondary College. <u>However, we strongly recommend that the School Transport System is used rather than students driving to school</u>. It is in the interest of safety for both the driver and the pedestrian that the following rules are observed:

- Driver of the vehicle must either have a Full Driver's Licence or the accompanying front seat passenger must be the holder of a Full Driver's Licence.
- Driver must be fully insured see next point.
- The School Principal must be advised in writing of the registered owner of the vehicle and confirmation that the driver is insured to drive the vehicle. School Principal must also receive written consent from parents/guardians that their son/daughter has permission to drive to school, as well as a copy of the student's Driving Licence.
- Cars are parked at owner's/student's risk while on College grounds. The College will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury caused to the vehicle or by the driver of the vehicle, or any loss or damage caused as a result of the vehicle being on the College grounds.
- Pedestrian movement takes precedence over vehicular movement. Car drivers must yield to pedestrians, and proceed slowly and with caution at all times. Maximum speed is 30km per hour.
- Students must park their cars at all times in the designated student parking area, which is the Front Car Park, entering and leaving through the first entrance/exit only on the left hand side as one approaches the car park. Students are not permitted to park in any other area of the College grounds.
- On entering the College students must drive their vehicle directly to the front car park, which is the only designated parking area. On exiting the College students must drive their vehicle directly out the front gate. Driving around the College grounds is not permitted.
- Students are not allowed to transport other students in their cars without parents/guardians written permission. This written permission from relevant parents must be forwarded to the School Principal.
- > Students are not to allow other students drive the cars.
- Students are not permitted to drive during the school day.

Breach of above rules will result in permission not being granted to park cars/motorbikes on the College grounds and parents/guardians will be contacted by School Principal.
